

Radical War

Essential Question: How do you compare the sizes of rational and irrational numbers?

Directions: You are going to play a game of war with the playing cards provided. However, these cards are not your average playing cards...they are radical! Use the page below to record each comparison you make.

Rules:

1. Split the deck of cards evenly between two players/teams.
2. Don't look at your cards.
3. Both players/teams put down a card at the same time face up.
4. The player/team with the higher value cards keeps both cards.
 - a. If the cards are the same value then it means WAR. Each player/team puts 2 cards face down and one face up. The higher face up card wins. Continue the war until there is no longer a tie.
5. The player/team with the most cards at the end of the game wins.
